The Minibus Service to Ely run twice monthly by the Parish Council in partnership with Dial-a-Ride is set to improve. New times, effective from April, will extend the time in Ely to 3 hours on one of the trips each month while the second will remain at 2 hours.

A drop-off and pick-up point at the new Sainsburys store and also Ely Market is to be introduced also.
