PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCIES

Interested in being someone in the community that others will look to for help, guidance and support? Would you like to influence decisions for the benefit of Burwell residents? Then consider becoming a Parish Councillor.

Burwell Parish Council currently has two vacancies. A candidate for a Parish Council is qualified if, when nominated:

- he or she is a British Subject or citizen of the European Union or Ireland,
- has attained 18 years of age, and
- is either: in the register of electors for that Parish/Town, or has during the whole of the preceding twelve months:- occupied land as owner or tenant, had a principal place of work there, or resided in or within 4.8 kilometres (three miles) of it.

LOCAL PLAN

East Cambridge District Council have produced an outline scheme for the Newmarket Road development which will be available for public consultation from the 17th April to 30th May. Residents can take the opportunity to discuss the development with Parish Councillors at the Annual Parish meeting on the 6th of May.

ANNUAL REVIEW

The Annual Report reviewing the Council's activities for the past year will be available on the Parish Council website, the Jubilee Reading Room and the Library from the beginning of May.

CAUSEWAY VERGE

Concerns have been expressed relating to the condition of the grass verges on the Causeway, with particular emphasis on unlawful driving across of the verges, the vehicular use of footpaths to access to grass verges and the parking of vehicles entirely on the grass verges themselves. Letters are to be sent to residents of the road concerning the issue and the police are aware. We ask that users of the road respect the law, pedestrians and residents both on this and the many other roads through our village.

SKATE PARK

Following contact made by two of the town younger residents concerning the village skate park, the Parish Council has recently had a full inspection of the site undertaken. Maintenance and repair of the ramps will take place of the coming weeks. We were very pleased to have been informed by the equipment suppliers that the skate park is in overall very good condition and is well taken care of by its users. **Thank you.**
