TOILET FUTURE STILL TO BE DECIDED

East Cambridgeshire District Council will recommend closure of Burwell toilets on The Causeway at their meeting on 22nd June.

The Parish Council have already decided that there is a need for facilities to be available in the village. We are considering options for toilets, near to the Jubilee Reading Room, that will also be accessible to those with disabilities.

The Causeway Verge

Our application to the Local Highways Improvement Grant for help to improve the Causeway was unsuccessful for the third time. Council has therefore agreed to fund the work entirely. Estimates for the work have been requested from three companies, and the work will be commissioned as soon as possible after these have been fully investigated.

ANGLIAN WATER - POLLUTION WATCH

Anglian Water is launching a new campaign called Pollution Watch. It is all about **Spotting, Reporting** and **Stopping** sewage pollution incidents as quickly as possible and to minimise the impact to the environment.

Escapes from the sewage system are commonly caused by the build-up of fats, oils and greases, sanitary waste and wipes, all of which cause blockages and reduce the flow of sewage through the network. There are many tell-tale signs that pollution has entered a river or a stream. These include:

- sewage solids
- toilet debris such as toilet paper, condoms and sanitary products
 - soap suds or a milky-looking discharge in the water
 - grey coloured water
 - a noticeable sewage smell

By calling our Pollution Hotline on **03457 145 145** and informing us about potential sewage pollution issues, we can respond sooner meaning we have the best opportunity to minimise any environmental impact.
